

Lead Based Paint Program

Summit County is working in partnership with the Summit County Health District to provide assistance to income qualified residents that have lead based paint hazards in their home. Applicants must have children under the age of 6 that either reside in the home or visit more than 62 hours a year. A lead risk assessment is conducted on each unit to verify where the lead hazard is located.

In addition to the lead program, qualified applicants may qualify for additional grants for minor home improvements to their house.
