
PUBLIC INPUT

**Request for Speed Limit Reduction
Mayfair Rd, Springfield Township**

**Mayfair Rd in township is Summit County Maintenance
Request for Springfield Township Trustees and Police submit
speed reduction proposal to Summit County**

Current speed limit is 40 MPH.

Requests:

- 1. Reduction to 35 MPH**
- 2. Creation enforcement zone on Mayfair & Killian Roads**
- 3. Consider physical speed reduction speed bumps**

Reasons:

- 1. Inconsistent speed limit on Mayfair, 40 MPH of Springfield section for approximately ¼ mile, 35 MPH Green section.**
- 2. Intersection at Massillon Rd with Mayfair is not a 90 degree turn but an oblique which allows a higher rate of acceleration going onto Mayfair Rd.**
- 3. In the acceleration zone is the only entrance to carwash.**
- 4. After the carwash entrance is a slight dog leg curve that includes the Piercy Drive allotment access. My residence is opposite Piercy Drive and I have observed numerous vehicles with excessive acceleration along with vehicles that go left of center due to the slight dog leg. Drivers that are left of center appear to have their heads down possibly looking at their cellphones.**
- 5. There are numerous residence driveway accesses in the Springfield section until Nichols Drive.**

6. There has been an increase in bike ridership on Mayfair. Mayfair Rd is a standard two lane highway but the issue is there is very little berm width and the berm is not a hard surface (good example is Killian Rd).
7. Mayfair Road is in the same police district as Arlington Road business area and does this reduce police activities on Mayfair Road.
8. Excessive speed and reckless operation especially bad during the drive home time period.
9. Pressler Road is 35 MPH and the same housing density.

Action path forward:

1. Trustees and Police Chief promulgate corrective actions.
2. Trustees and Police Chief elicit community response.
3. Trustees and Police Chief provide written response.
