

1. New subscribers with Republic Services must call to sign up for service and to confirm they would like to have a container for recycling and a container for waste. **You will not automatically be signed up for this service.**
2. Recycling service is also included. Residents wanting to participate should confirm with their Republic Services representative that they would like to obtain a 65-gallon recycling container, which is included in this service. Recycling collections will be every other week on the same day as your waste collection. A calendar is provided to show where the truck will collect on scheduled days, according to where you live within the township.
3. Waste service will be provided weekly and a 96-gallon container will be included for each home owner. Residents wanting a container must notify customer service when they call in. If you already have a container, simply confirm that fact with the representative.
4. The rate for service is \$16.00 per month for both recycling and waste, which includes the recycling and waste containers. You will be invoiced for these services quarterly.
5. Senior citizens over 65 years old are eligible for a discounted rate of \$14.40 per month. You will be invoiced for these services quarterly.
6. Bulk items are included at no additional charge. Tires will not be collected and appliances containing Freon® are required to have the gas removed by a certified technician and tagged as such, prior to collection. Mattresses and box springs must be wrapped and sealed in plastic for bulk collection.
7. Republic Services Customer Service number is 800.247.3644.
8. Holidays – the six major holidays may cause a one-day delay in your collection. See the attached map to determine the impact of your collection day.
9. Container locations – please set your containers at the curb with the handles facing away from the street. Containers should not be under limbs or low wires and should be a minimum of 3 feet away from poles, light fixtures and mailboxes. Also, please separate the recycling and waste containers by at least 3 feet. They can be placed on opposite sides of the driveway.
10. All recyclable material should be **empty, clean and dry**. Please rinse all food and beverage containers completely prior to placing in the container. (For example, no ketchup or mustard may be left in the bottles.)
11. Recyclable items include newsprint, paper, plastic food and beverage containers, aluminum cans, steel cans, cardboard and corrugated boxes.
12. Non-recyclable items include drums, ashes, tires, batteries, car parts, medical waste, liquid waste of any kind, paint and contaminated (uncleaned) recyclables.

Republic Services® is closed for the 6 major holidays identified in red. On these holiday weeks, your collection could be delayed one day. Recycling is collected on the same day as your waste.


Waste is collected every week and should be placed at the curb by 6 a.m. on your collection day. Please locate your neighborhood on the map to the right, which will help you identify your collection day.

## Collection Schedule

All recycling will be collected every other week on the same day as your waste collection. All waste will be collected Monday through Friday (see map).

**Unlimited Service** – Residents will receive a 65-gallon recycling container and a 96-gallon waste container, and can put an unlimited amount of weekly recycling and household waste at the curb. **The cost for the Unlimited Service is \$48.00 per quarter.**

**Senior Citizen Rate** – Senior citizens generally produce much less material and many times are on a limited income. **The special Senior Citizen Rate is \$43.20 per quarter.**

## Acceptable Recycling Materials



Cardboard (flattened), office paper, file folders, magazines, catalogs, newspaper and inserts, junk mail, telephone books, etc.



Aluminum, tin, or steel cans, foil and pie tins



Milk cartons, juice cartons, and aseptic containers
